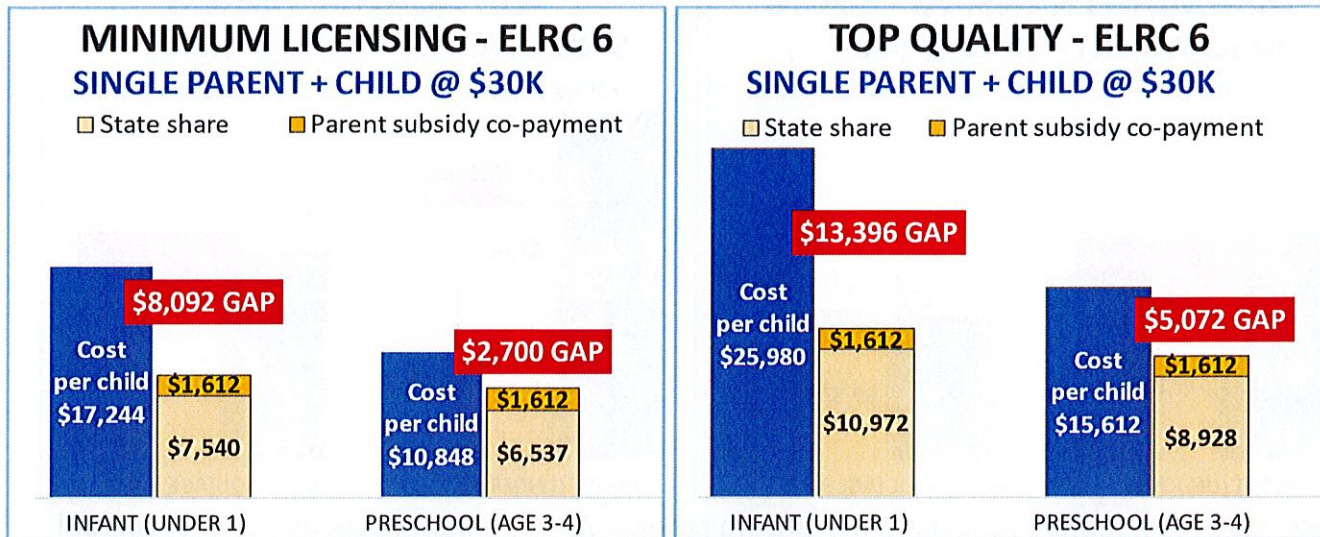
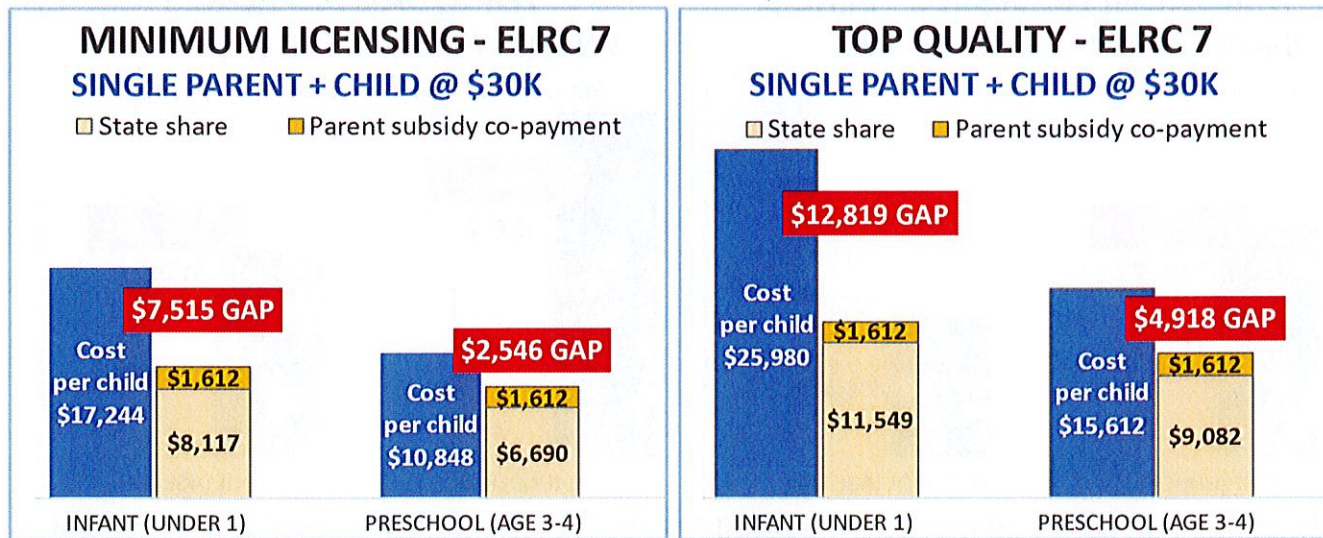


REGION 6: BEDFORD, BLAIR, CAMBRIA, FRANKLIN, FULTON, HUNTINGDON, SOMERSET



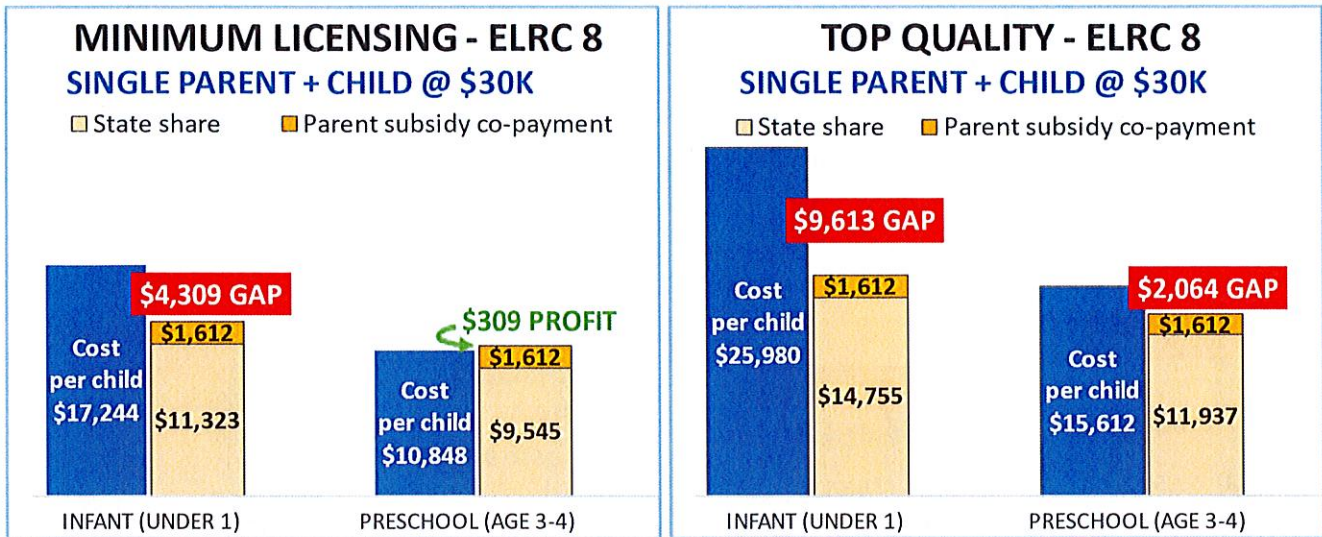
ELRC Region 6 centers at minimum licensing receive 53% of infant costs and 75% of preschool subsidized care. Top quality providers have a cost gap of 52% (\$13,396) for infant care and 32% (\$5,072) for preschool care per child.

REGION 7: CLINTON, LYCOMING, TIOGA



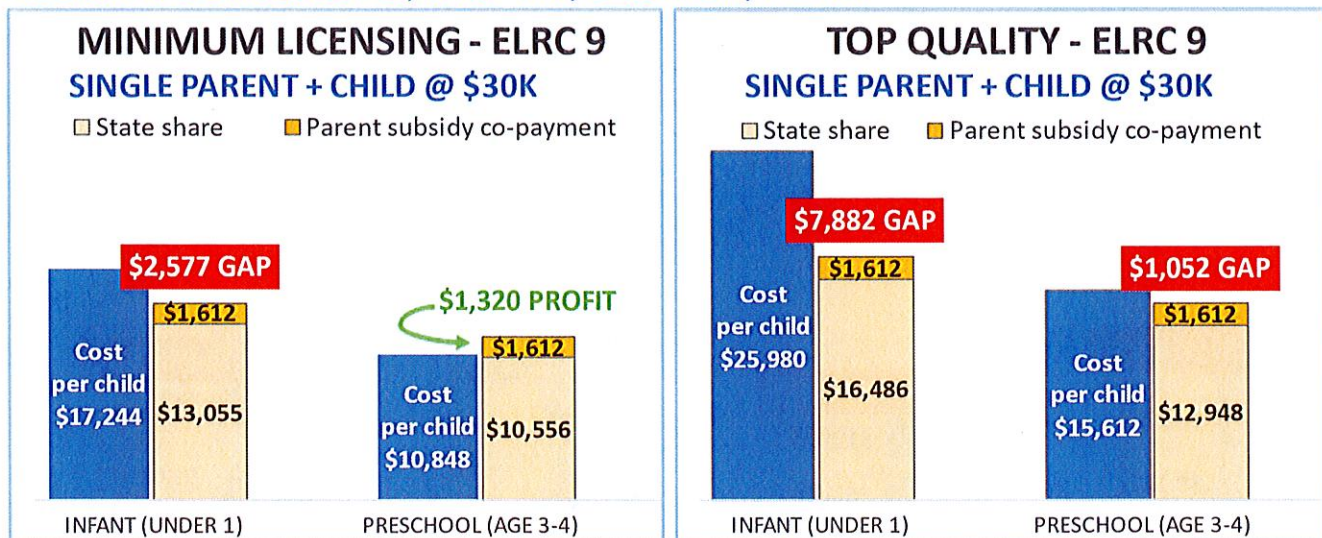

REGION 8: CENTRE, JUNIATA, MIFFLIN, NORTHUMBERLAND, SNYDER, UNION



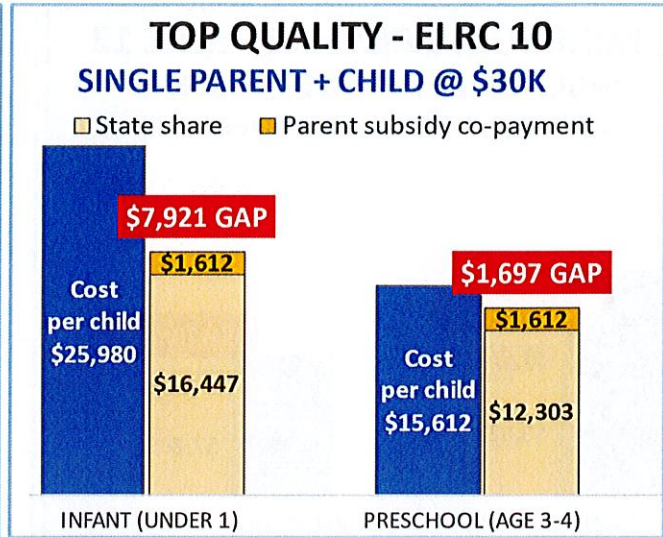
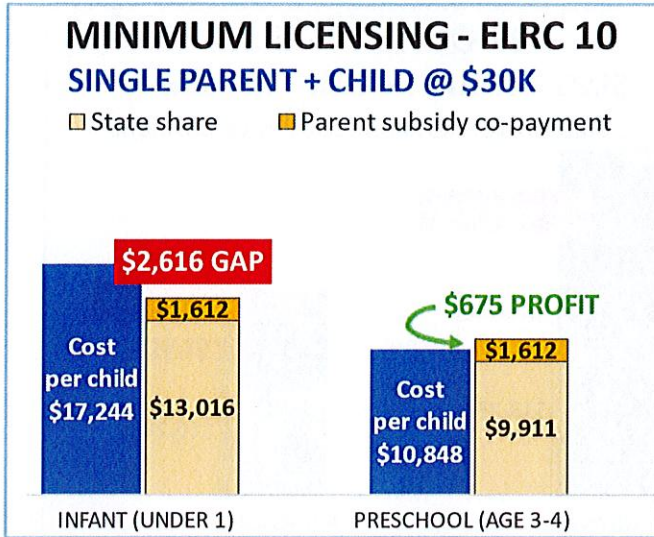

REGION 9: CUMBERLAND, DAUPHIN, LEBANON, PERRY



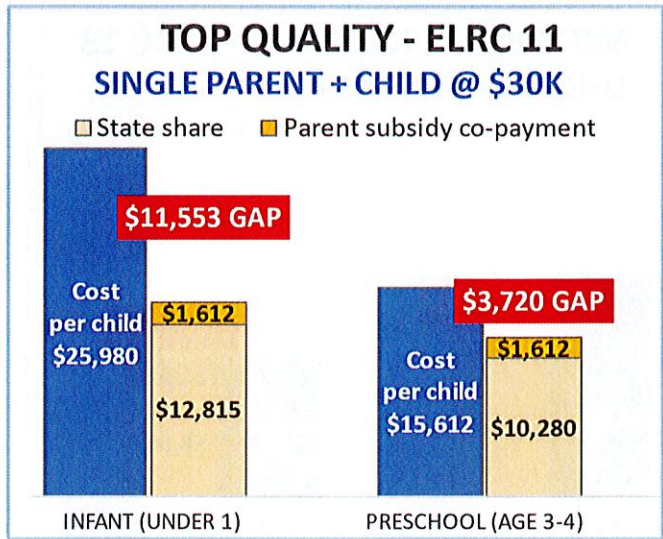
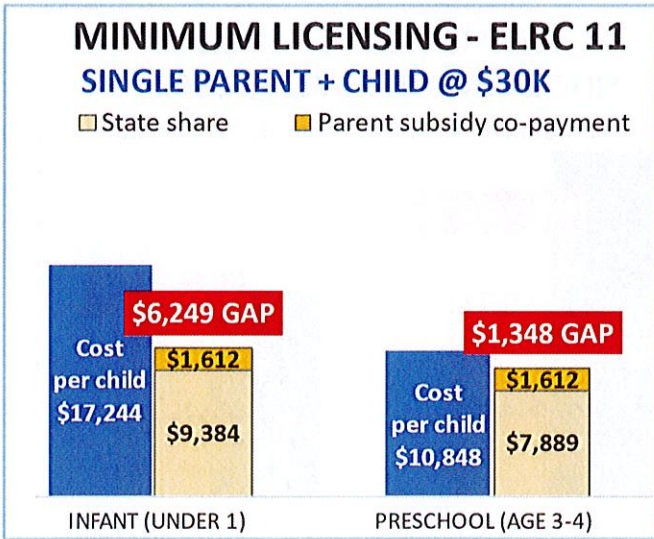
ELRC Region 9 centers at minimum licensing receive 85% of infant costs and see an annual profit of \$1,320 for preschool subsidized care. Top quality providers have a cost gap of 30% (\$7,882) for infant care and 7% (\$1,052) for preschool care per child.

REGION 10: ADAMS, LANCASTER, YORK



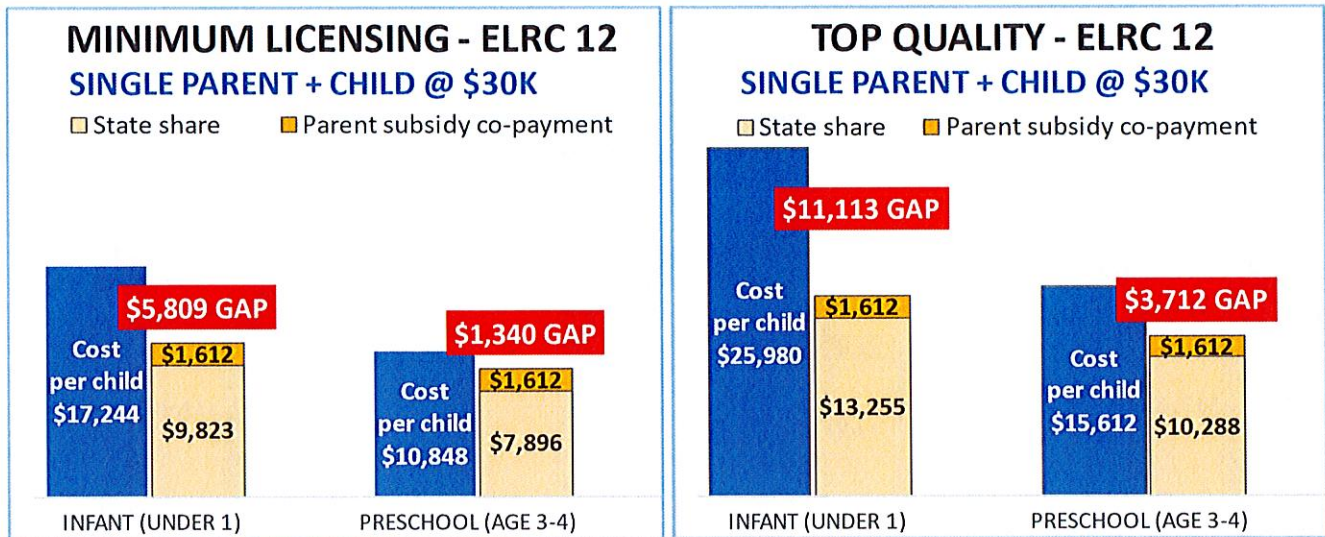
ELRC Region 10 centers at minimum licensing receive 85% of infant costs and see an annual profit of \$675 for preschool subsidized care. Top quality providers have a cost gap of 30% (\$7,921) for infant care and 11% (\$1,697) for preschool care per child.

REGION 11: BRADFORD, COLUMBIA, LUZERNE, MONTOUR, SULLIVAN, WYOMING



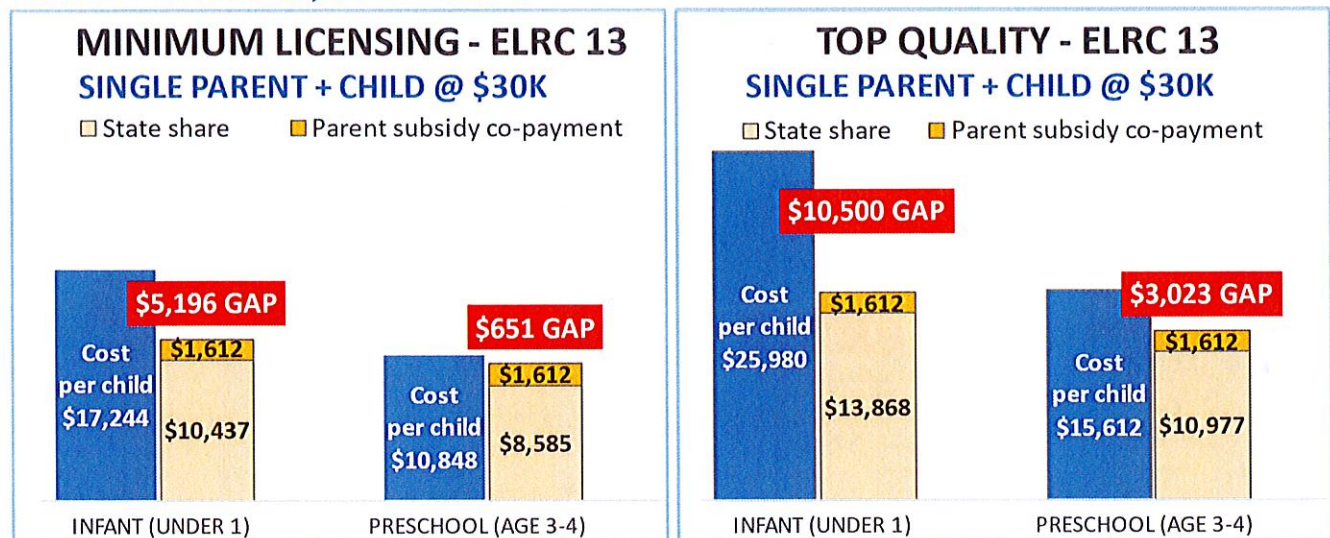
ELRC Region 11 centers at minimum licensing receive 63% of infant costs and 88% of preschool subsidized care. Top quality providers have a cost gap of 44% (\$11,553) for infant care and 24% (\$3,270) for preschool care per child.

REGION 12: CARBON, LACKAWANNA, MONROE, PIKE, SUSQUEHANNA, WAYNE



ELRC Region 12 centers at minimum licensing receive 66% of infant costs and 88% of preschool subsidized care. Top quality providers have a cost gap of 43% (\$11,113) for infant care and 24% (\$3,712) for preschool care per child.

REGION 13: BERKS, SCHUYLKILL



ELRC Region 13 centers at minimum licensing receive 70% of infant costs and 94% of preschool subsidized care. Top quality providers have a cost gap of 40% (\$10,500) for infant care and 19% (\$3,023) for preschool care per child.
